PART II: NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the reporting period, the Battalion was responsible for the Eastern sector of the 9th Marines TAOR. This responsibility included the occupation and defense of the assigned sector from enemy attack, execution of offensive operations in the assigned sector, maintaining the Main Supply Route open to traffic, establishment and maintenance of a reconnaissance network in the assigned sector, preparation to execute offensive operations beyond the assigned sector, and the support of pacification programs as directed. The predominately successful tactic continued to be the cordon type Company (Rein) Rabbit Hunt Search and Destroy operations and the similar County Fairs. In each case, a cordon was established during hours of darkness. The Search and Destroy operations and the sweep part of the County Fair lasted a maximum of eight hours. In each case, no more than four grid squares were covered, so as to insure control. Adjacent units, including 3rd Bn, 7th Marines, 2nd Bn, 4th Marines, and 2nd Bn, 1st Marines assisted with blocking forces when any of the cordon boundaries were contiguous to boundaries of these units. A total of five Search and Destroy operations and three County Fairs were conducted. At 210801H January 1967 the sectors of this unit's TAOR were adjusted to conform to Enclosure (14). Day and night patrols and ambush activities of Squad (Rein) sized units were conducted throughout the month by all companies. 1st Bn, 26th Marines CP was visited by the Commandant of the Marine Corps on 8 January.

PART III: SEQUENTIAL LISTING
OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. Personnel. During the period the Battalion had a gain in officer and enlisted strength.

a. Losses are as follows:

(1) 3 Marine officers transferred for duty and one (1) transferred by service records by reason of med-evac.

(2) 39 Marine enlisted transferred for duty and 35 by service records by reason of med-evac.

(3) One (1) USN enlisted transferred for duty and one (1) by service records by reason of med-evac.

b. Joinings are as follows:

(1) 14 Marine and one (1) Navy officer joined for duty.

(2) 174 Marine and two (2) Navy enlisted joined for duty.

c. Casualties for the period are as follows:

(1) One (1) Marine enlisted KIA and one (1) Marine enlisted DOW.

(2) Three (3) Marine officers, 51 Marine and 3 Navy enlisted WIA.

2. Administration. Nothing significant.

3. Intelligence.

a. Enemy Contacts. There were no major contacts during the month. The significant contacts were:

(1) 031100 Co D while conducting S&D operations in CHAU SON vic (AT 950605), apprehended 2 PW, 1 Civil Defendant, and 1 weapon. 1 PW was a member of the R-20 LF Bn. The Co C blocking force also inflicted 2 VC KIA (Conf) and 2 VC KIA (Prob) during the action.

(2) 141620 Co C sqd patrol received 200 rounds small arms fire from (AT 975594), (AT 978597) and (AT 972598) resulting in 1 USMC KIA and 1 USMC WIA. Returned fire resulted in 4 VC KIA (Prob).

(3) 310725 Co G in a blocking position observed 16 VC attempting to swim river (AT 982611) to escape the sweep force. Fired 60 rounds of small arms resulting in 14 VC KIA (Conf) and 2 PW. Co D sweep force returned fire at sniper resulting in 1 VC KIA (Conf), 1 PW (WIA), and 1 M-14 rifle captured.

(4) Mine activity greatly increased. Liberty Road North was heavily mined. Seven mines were surprise detonated and nine were found. The activity resulted in 7 USMC WIA. Two mines were detonated on Route 14, resulting in the loss of two LVTP-5's and 22 USMC WIA.

b. Surveillance. Continuous use was made of the surveillance devices available. Amplifier problems reduced the availability of the AN/TPS-21. The Starlight Scope was deadlined at TMSG during the entire month. The Seismic Intrusion Detectors were employed at all fixed positions, but no contacts were made. The Battalion Snipers continued to employ the M-49 Spotting Telescope. Several significant sniper sightings occurred, resulting in 5 VC KIA (Conf), 1 VC WIA (PW), and 34 VC KIA (Prob).

c. Counterintelligence. Subteam 6 of the 3rd IFF was attached to the Battalion during the month of January. A current Blacklist of VC and Cadre personalities was compiled and distributed. There are strong indications that the VC Infrastructure in the central portion of the TAOB has been crippled as a result of recent operations.

d. Weather. January was characterized by improving weather conditions. The majority of the rainfall occurred during the first five days of the month. The latter third of the month was hot and dry. The road net had dried and was trafficable on Liberty Road North and Liberty Road South. Route 14 was open to tracked vehicles only. Cross-country movement for foot troops was greatly improved. The complete synopsis of the weather for January follows:

4. Training. On the job training was conducted for all MOS's, and the five day indoctrination period for newly arrived personnel continued. In addition a more sophisticated indoctrination program for newly arrived officers and staff NCO's was set up and conducted. This included Operations, Air Support, FO Procedures and Demolitions.

A total of 700 Marines from this command FAM-fired the M-16 rifle. All newly arrived personnel fired their M-14's for battle sights.

5. Special Operations. County Fairs 9-36, 9-37, 9-38 were held respectively in XUAN DIEM (1) (AT 961625) on 13-14 January, in CHAU SON (3) (AT 956604) on 25-27 January, and in THAI CAM (3) (AT 975620) on 28-29 January. A total of 1044 Vietnamese civilians were screened, revealing 1 PW, 2 Civil Defendants and 1 Detainee. Friendly casualties consisted of one WIA and one NBC, both from Gunshot. See Supporting Documents.

Five one day Company (Rein) sized Rabbit Hunt Search and Destroy operations were held in CHAU SON (1) and (2) vic (AT 945607), LE SON (3) THAI CAM (1) and (2) vic (AT 977645), CAM VAN (1) and (2) vic (AT 961598), LE SON (4) AN TRACH (3) vic (AT 960560) and DUC KY (1) vic (AT 980613). In each case the area was cordoned off by blocking forces of adjoining units both from this battalion and from neighboring battalions along natural and man made terrain features. The area was then swept and searched thoroughly. Results were outstanding, including 22 VC KIA (Conf), 1 VC KIA (Prob), 6 PW's, 3 Civil Defendants and 16 Detainees. Fifteen of the VC KIA (Conf) and 3 of the PW's were inflicted during the DUC KY (1) operation.

At 281655H a Co B squad landed as the "Sparrow Hawk" at coordinates (AT 964563). Results were 2 PW, 2 U.S. automatic carbines, 5 frag grenades, four packs, and some miscellaneous notebooks and documents.

At 290915H Co D landed as the "Bald Eagle" reaction force to support 2nd Bn, 5th Marines in their TAOR.

6. Nuclear, Biological and Chemical Warfare. Nothing significant.

7. Command and Control. The Battalion was commanded by LtCol D.E. NEWTON throughout the reporting period, and remained intact except for 270915H to 291700H January when Company D, deployed as a "Bald Eagle" reaction force, was OPCON to 2nd Bn, 5th Marines. 1st Bn, 26th Marines remains ADCON 3rd Marine Division and OPCON 1st Marine Division.

On 210801H January, this Battalion enlarged its TAOR to the North, East, and South. See enclosure (14).

8. Communications and Electronics. Nothing significant.

9. Close Combat. Nothing significant.

10. Fire Support and Fire Support Coordination. During January artillery fired on targets of opportunity, fired zone fires on suspected enemy positions, harassment and interdiction fires, and registration missions. Both offensive and defensive on-call fires were utilized during the reporting period.

a. Artillery fired 92 missions against a known enemy during January. [REDACTED] resulting from artillery were reported to be 21 KIA (Conf),

and 60 KLA (Prob). Confirmed figures might have been higher, but conditions in many cases precluded an immediate search of target area. Surveillance by FO's indicated that artillery was both effective and accurate. There were also 12 missions of a Registration type carried out.

b. Two 81mm Mortar sections were attached to outlying rifle companies while the third and fourth were kept on Hill 55, one on Hill 55 proper, and the other on Hill 55 Finger 1, in a general support role. Mortar H&I's, observed and unobserved, were fired during the month of January.

c. Artillery and mortar missions and ammo expenditure figures for the reporting period are as follows:

11. Logistics. During this reporting period, the companies were supplied a total of 198,785 lbs of supplies. These supplies were transported 5,983 miles by M54 trucks and 216 miles by LVTP-5s, and 8 flying hours by H34 helicopters. In addition to these supplies each of the forward companies were supplied at least one hot meal each day except for a three day period when the road was closed. Battalion vehicles traveled 25,448 miles in support of the battalion.

Significant developments in the cantonment program include the construction of six machinegun bunkers, two command bunkers, six tropical huts, three tent decks, two heads and a bridge security bunker.

New weapons and ammunition introduced into the system during the reporting period include the M16 rifle for training purposes, and 60mm WP and 60mm Illumination ammunition.

Motor Transport repair parts remain a problem. Currently the Battalion has 4 M422's and 6 M274A2's deadlined for 2nd echelon repairs which cannot be accomplished due to the lack of the necessary repair parts.

12. Air Defense. Nothing significant.

13. Combat Air Support. Air support was used by this command during the

reporting period in support of ground units. A total of 48 medevacs were flown bringing 44 US casualties and 31 civilians to immediate medical aid. Three non battle casualties and three PW's were also evacuated. Of the 48 medevac missions, 24 were of an emergency nature. Six fixed wing sorties were flown in support of this Battalion during the reporting period. UH-1E gunships were used as medevac escort and on occasion as strike aircraft. One UH-34D was utilized for an aerial recon of the Battalion TAOR by unit commanders and O-1 observation aircraft were utilized when available.

14. Medical and Dental. During the month, 934 Marines were treated at routine sick call. 45 Marine WIA's, 21 of whom were released for duty, and 2 Marine KIA's were handled through the Battalion Aid Station. Average in-patient census for the month was 15.

86 Vietnamese civilians were treated at the Battalion Aid Station and another 437 were treated through field MEDCAP facilities.

The Dental Facility treated 125 Marines from this command, and 175 Vietnamese civilians through DENTCAP.

15. Chaplain and Moral Welfare. Protestant coverage was given by the Battalion Chaplain. Protestant services were held in the Battalion CP on Sundays and on Wednesday evenings and in the forward Company CP's on other weekdays. A total of 22 services were attended by 634 Marines. Eight Bible classes were attended by 92 Marines. The Battalion Chaplain counseled 56 Marines, visited 74 patients in 1st Med Bn and NSA Hospital, wrote one pastoral letter to next of kin of a deceased Marine, and handled 3 cases for the American Red Cross.

Roman Catholic coverage was given by 9th Marines Regimental Chaplain with Mass in the Battalion CP on Sundays and in the forward line companies on weekdays when possible.

16. Civic Action. On three separate occasions villagers from nearby hamlets presented miniature trees to the Battalion. This was their token of good luck for our New Year. It was in appreciation for services contributed, specifically for the daily MEDCAP program and County Fairs. Three County Fairs were conducted during the reporting period; in XUAN DIEM (2) (AT 961625), CHAU SON (3) (AT 956604) and in THAI CAM (3) (AT 975620). Total results were 1049 civilians screened, 812 examined and treated at MEDCAP and 185 examined and treated through DENTCAP. MEDCAP facilities operated daily throughout the period.

During the County Fairs a detachment from the 244th Psychological Warfare Company showed propaganda movies, cartoons and played propaganda tapes and music. There were three air drops of PsyWar leaflets in the Battalion's TAOR during the reporting period and patrols distributed leaflets daily. The theme was CHIEU HOI, with emphasis on the approaching TET celebration.

4. (a) Objective. To locate, capture or destroy enemy forces and conduct civic action/psychological operations, to further the Pacification program and assist in Revolutionary development.

(b) Analysis. The County Fair was very successful in establishing rapport among Marines, Government Officials, ARVN Troops, and the villagers. All VC influence was separated from the people at least for the period of the Fair, and a cordial and receptive atmosphere existed during the Civic Action/Psychological operation activities.

A survey was taken among all villagers to determine their market facilities, desirability of a market in the immediate area, and any help that could be rendered by Marines of this command. Pictures were taken of each family to be matched with names for future identification. At all times an extremely friendly attitude was evident among the people.

12. It is the opinion of this commander that utilization of Agricultural, Cultural Drama, and VIS Teams would contribute much to the success of future County Fair operations.

4. (a) Objective. To locate, capture or destroy enemy forces and conduct civic action/psychological operations, to further the Pacification program and assist in Revolutionary development.

(b) Analysis. The County Fair was very successful in establishing rapport among Marines, Government Officials, ARVN Troops, and the villagers. All VC influence was separated from the people at least for the period of the fair, and an extremely friendly and receptive atmosphere existed during the Civic Action/Psychological operation activities.

8. Effect on Infrastructure. The PW was identified by a village chief as a member of the local guerrilla force.

- (c) 50 gallons of Kool Aid distributed
- (d) 35 gallons of soup distributed
- (e) 7 bags (700 lbs.) of rice distributed
- (f) 4 bags (400 lbs.) of corn distributed
- (g) Marines played Soccer and Volley Ball with men and children of the village.
- (h) Men and children participated in sack and three legged races. Distributed candy and cigarettes for awards.
- (i) Showed three (3) films on personal hygiene and child care. Total 30 minutes. After films, Doctor gave lecture and demonstration on proper method of bathing a child with soap and water.

10. Psychological Operations.

- (a) Three (3) hours of propaganda films and cartoons.
- (b) One half hour propaganda speech by a CHIEU HOI, who also wrote four (4) letters and gave them to villagers to pass out to any VC who come into the village.
- (c) Distributed 100 propaganda magazines.
- (d) Village chief read newspaper to people who could not read.
- (e) VIS speaker gave one hour lecture on CHIEU HOI and how the Marines help the villagers, and that they should inform the Marines when the VC come into their village.
- (f) Three hours of propaganda speeches by VIS and village chiefs on the following subjects:
 - (1) Conduct of villagers
 - (2) Unrest in NVN
 - (3) How the Marines help the people.

11. Other Significant Results. Pictures were taken of each family to be matched with names for future identification. S-5 and village chiefs met with village elders in a question and answer session. Topics such as how to build protective bunkers, what to do if wounded, and how the Marines can help the villagers were discussed. The villagers also requested that fertilizer, a school, and a well be furnished for their village.

12. The people appeared extremely happy and grateful for food and Medical care. Men and children were quite cooperative and friendly in participating in the athletics with the Marines. After the Doctors demonstrated, many women were observed washing their young children in the previously prescribed manner. It is also noted that these particular villagers were better disciplined than previous villagers.
