PART II: NARRATIVE SUMMARY

From 1 May until 5 May, the Battalion was responsible for the Eastern Sector of the 7th Marines Sector of the DANANG TAOR. This responsibility included the occupation and defense of the assigned sector from enemy attack, execution of offensive operations in the assigned sector, maintaining the Main Supply Route open to traffic, establishment and maintenance of a reconnaissance network in the assigned sector and the support of pacification programs as directed.

On 2 May, the boundaries of the Battalion's sector changed significantly to include an extension of the Southern boundary 5,000 meters south of the SONG THU BON River. The Eastern boundary was located 500 meters west of the National Railroad. The western boundary followed the east bank of the SONG VU GIA and SONG AI NGHIA Rivers. The Northern boundary was 63 East-West Grid Line. New areas of responsibility for the companies were established immediately and the defense was accomplished efficiently, expeditiously and without incident.

The Battalion chopped OpCon from the 1st Marine Division to the 3rd Marine Division on 6 May. On 3, 4, and 5 May preparations were made to relocate the Battalion to PHU BAI. On 5 May, the 1st Battalion, 7th Marines relieved the Battalion of its responsibility of the Eastern sector of the 7th Marines TAOR. The airlift of the Battalion from DANANG to PHU BAI commenced and was complete on 6 May. The Battalion Command Post opened at PHU BAI on 6 May. The Battalion's supplies and equipment arrived at PHU BAI from DANANG by Rough Rider on 9 May.

A mission was assigned in Operation CUMBERLAND and immediate preparations were made and missions assigned to subordinate units. Prior to the commencement of Operation CUMBERLAND, the Battalion's mission was changed to responsibility for the assigned portion of the KHE SANH Operating Area. The airlift of the Battalion to KHE SANH commenced on 11 May with supplies and equipment following on subsequent flights. The Battalion Command Post (Forward) was opened the same day.

The Battalion's mission was to occupy key terrain features to prevent enemy movement into vital areas and conduct extensive and intensive patrolling in order to detect and destroy enemy forces and interdict enemy routes of approach into the KHE SANH area. Additionally, the Battalion was responsible for providing a Rifle Company (Rein) as Regimental Reserve, a force for Sparrow Hawk, Rough Rider Relief, perimeter security for the KHE SANH Airfield and facilities and a relief force for the LANG VEI Special Forces Camp. On the 13th, Operation CROCKETT commenced. Search and destroy and reconnaissance in force missions were assigned to the Battalion.

During the reporting period, friendly activity consisted mainly of extensive company daylight combat and reconnaissance in force patrols and platoon night ambushes. Additionally, Company Patrol Bases were established on Hills 861 and 881S.

On 19 May, Company A on Hill 881S was visited by BGEN METZGER and BGEN RYAN. On 22 May, ADM SHARI, LTGEN WALT, and MAJ GEN HOCHMUTH visited Company A on Hill 881S and Company C on Hill 861. On 29 May, BGEN METZGER visited Company B on Hill 881S.

PART III: SEQUENTIAL LISTING  
OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. Personnel

a. Losses are as follows:

2. Administrative

a. A Battalion S-1 forward, consisting of the assistant adjutant and 2 clerks, was established at KHE SANH on 11 May 1967. It's primary mission was casualty reporting and liaison between the companies and S-1 rear. No significant problems were encountered. Mail delivery from PHU BAI was unsatisfactory. The Battalion moved to KHE SANH on 11 May 1967, the first mail delivered was on 18 May and consisted of approximately 40 bags, the next delivery was 4 bags on 23 May and 24 May. On 27 May one bag of rework mail was delivered by a Battalion Rear courier. On 31 May, 27 bags were received from DONG HA that had been shuttled from PHU BAI on the 29th or 30th of May. Information was received on 31 May that plans were to schedule regular mail delivery service each day or every other day according to availability of air transportation.

3. Intelligence

a. Enemy Activity. Enemy activities for the month of May was light. The following significant contacts occurred during the month:

- (1) On the 22nd, 15 NVA bodies which had been dead approximately 3 weeks were found at KD 778450. The bodies had been placed in bunkers by the NVA with feet and ankles tied together, apparently for carrying on poles.

(2) On the 21st, Co A patrol, searching area of air strikes, spotted 6-8 NVA moving near a fortified position. Called in arty mission of 155mm rds, observed a direct hit on position containing 3 enemy. Immediately after bunker was hit, patrol received 10 incoming mortar rounds. Could not spot mortar position. Three minutes later received 500 rounds of auto and semi auto fire from XD 758460. At same time received approximately 1,000 rounds M. G. fire from four positions at XD 750465. Returned heavy S/A fire and M-79 fire resulting in 10 NVA KIA (C). Received more S/A fire from XD 758460. Arty mission called, resulting in 15 NVA KIA. Continued to receive M. G. fire from XD 750465. Air strikes and artillery missions were continued and the results of the incident were 25 NVA KIA(C), 27 NVA KIA(F), 2 USMC KIA and 8 USMC WIA.

(3) On the 18th, Co A, located 3 shafts each 3' in diameter and estimated to be 80' deep. The shafts had been camouflaged. Discussion with the local Montaguard Chief revealed subterranean caverns exists in the KHE SANH area. Investigation is continuing into the possibility of these caves being used as storage areas.

b. Weather. The month was generally dry. All lines of communication were open to wheeled vehicles and movement of infantry was unimpaired.

4. Training. On the job training was conducted for all MOS's. The seven day indoctrination period which was introduced this month for newly arrived personnel was considered to be extremely effective. A familiarization firing of the M-16 rifle was conducted for all newly joined personnel and a refresher course held for infantry personnel in the Battalion. In addition, the month's training was highlighted by on the job training for infantry company key personnel on bunker construction.

5. Special Operations. The Battalion was moved to PHU BAI on 6 May 1967 and preparation was made for participation in Operation CUMBERLAND. On 11 May 1967 the Battalion was relieved of responsibility for Operation CUMBERLAND and was assigned responsibility for the assigned sector of the KHE SANH Area of Operation.

6. NBC Defense. Nothing Significant.
7. Command and Control. The Battalion was commanded by LtCol D.E. NEWTON throughout the reporting period. 1st Battalion, 26th Marines remained ADCON 3rd Marine Division and GICOM 7th Marine Regiment until the Battalion chopped OpCon on 6 May 1967 to the 26th Marine Regiment.
8. Communication and Electronics. Nothing Significant.
9. Close Combat. Nothing Significant.
10. Fire Support and Fire Support Coordination. During May, artillery fired on targets of opportunity, fired zone fires on suspected enemy positions, harassment and interdiction fires and registration missions. Both offensive and defensive on-call fires were utilized during the reporting period.

Artillery fired 151 missions against known enemy during May. Casualties resulting from artillery were reported to be 16 KIA(C) and 29 KIA(F). Confirmed figures might have been higher but conditions in many cases precluded an immediate search of the target area. Surveillance by FO's indicated that artillery was both effective and accurate.

Two 81mm Mortar sections were attached to outlying rifle companies while the other two sections were kept in the KHE SANH airfield perimeter in a general support role. Mortars H&S's observed and unobserved fire missions were fired during May.

11. Logistics. During this reporting period the entire Battalion displaced from DANANG to THU BAI. The Battalion moved 935 personnel and 2650 cubic feet of cargo by C-130. The remaining personnel and 58,500 cubic feet of cargo were trucked to THU BAI.

Later the Battalion displaced to KHE SANH by C-130. Total personnel and equipment moved were 900 personnel and 4140 cubic feet of cargo.

12. Air Defense. Nothing significant.

13. Combat Air Support. On arrival at KHE SANH Base, the battalion air section deployed two forward air control parties with forward companies to Hills 861 and 881 South. The teams participated in all company size and several platoon size operations, providing fixed wing and helicopter control; and communications with reconnaissance aircraft flying in direct support. Excellent observation from both hills was exploited by both FAC's. They successfully completed a combined total of 51 ground controlled fixed wing airstrikes on adjacent high ground and avenues of approach to KHE SANH Base. These strikes and the fires they started destroyed large amounts of concealing vegetation on avenues of approach and set off numerous secondary explosions. On numerous occasions during the last half of the month UH-1E armed helicopters were employed in direct support of ground units in the field. The armed reconnaissance and close air support capability of these planes proved to be invaluable. The UH-1E's were based at KHE SANH during the day, resulting in emergency response time of 15 minutes, as opposed to an average of 30 minutes for fixed wing aircraft launched from other bases. Commencing on 11 May the forward companies were resupplied entirely by helicopter. A total of 192 tons of supplies, all classes were lifted in support of forward units. The air section (rear) and forward FAC's successfully coordinated and controlled 15 helicopter medevacs during the month.

14. Medical. In regard to personnel for the month of May 1967, there were 9 corpsmen transferred to other commands for duty, and one corpsman evacuated out of country due to hostile action. The Asst. Bn Surgeon was transferred to III MAF for duty and no replacement has been furnished to date. Nine corpsmen reported for duty (3 E-4's, 5 E-5's, and 1 E-2). During the month 2 corpsmen were WIA and both were treated and returned to full duty in the field. At the present time the medical personnel census stands at 1 Officer, and 53 enlisted personnel. The present location of BAS is at the West End of the runway, at KHE SANH air strip. At this time, the BAS is using 2 GE tents for treatment, medical administration, medical supply, and patient holding. Our present facility does not yet meet the minimum requirements for in-patient care determined by the Division SOP. Medical personnel at present are living in individual one, and two man fox holes. Improvements in process are the construction of one above ground medical bunker. Combat

causalties treated at BAS during the Month of May were 2 KIA and 13 WIA with 6 being treated and returned to full duty, and 7 treated and held at BAS or evacuated for further treatment. Average daily patient census at the BAS for the month was 10. During May 349 Marines, and 20 VN's were treated and seen at routine sick call. The number of immunizations given during May were 329. Before relocation of the BAS from Hill 55, 74 VN's were treated at our local Med Cap tent; but at the present time the BAS is not involved in a Med Cap program.

15. Chaplain and Moral Welfare. Battalion Chaplain 1/26 (Prot) was located at Hill 55 DANANG 1-5 May; at PHU BAI 6-11 May; at KHE SANH 12-31 May. Prot services were held for 1/26 CP Sunday mornings and evenings, and for rifle companies Sunday afternoons and weekdays. Battalion Chaplain normally spent two nights weekly with rifle companies on Hills 881 South and 861. Total of 21 Prot services held in the Battalion were attended by 729 Marines. One Bible Class held in Battalion CP attended by five Marines. Battalion Chaplain gave Chaplain's Orientation Lecture and Lecture on Vietnamese Religions and Customs to 19 replacement troops, counseled with 67 Marines, visited patients in BAS almost daily, made visits to 26 casualties in hospitals and C&C areas, wrote two pastoral letters to NOK of KIA's, handled six cases with AmCross, and distributed over 2,400 New Testaments and religious booklets.

Battalion Chaplain made liaison with four American missionaries in KHE SANH (Mr. and Mrs. John MILLER, Miss Eugenia JOHNSTON, Miss Pat BONNELL, all with Wycliffe Bible Translators), arranged for Mr. MILLER to speak at all Sunday services on 28 May, and announced plans for PROJECT MISSION HOME, a special Protestant offering for the missionaries during the first week of June.

During the period at KHE SANH, Battalion Chaplain provided Prot services weekly for CAP O-1, CAP O-2, CAP O-3, and Army Special Forces Camp at LANG VEI, conducting six services attended by 62 men.

While 1/26 was at PHU BAI, Roman Catholic Masses were provided by the Battalion Chaplain, 3/26. After arrival at KHE SANH, Battalion Chaplain 3/3 (Rom Cath) was scheduled to come to KHE SANH each Sunday, but was cancelled due to nonavailability of air transportation.

Moved along trail to edge of woodline, point man spotted 6-8 NVA moving around a fortified position. Called in artillery mission and pulled back from area. Re-called artillery, Precision. Observed 1 155mm rd. land on bunker with 3 NVA inside. Immediately after bunker was hit, A-3 received 10 incoming mortar rounds, resulting in 4 WIA's. Could not spot mortar position. 3 minutes after incoming mortars, received 500 rounds of auto and semi-auto from 758460, resulting in 1 KIA and 2 WIA's. At same time received 1000 rounds machine gun fire from 4 different positions, resulting in 1 KIA and 1 WIA. Estimate 250 rounds from each position located at 750465. Returned heavy small arms fire and M-79 fire into area where fire was received resulting in 10 NVA KIA(C). Received more incoming from vicinity of 758460 resulting in 1 WIA. Artillery stopped incoming from 758460 resulting in 15 KIA(C) NVA. Continued to receive machine gun fire from 750465. Definite lull in incoming for approximately 5-8 minutes. Med-evac started to come in, received 200 S/A rounds and could not land. Air continued strikes in area. Med-evac picked up 4 WIA. A-3 commenced withdraw as directed. Fixed wing continued to strike area and received auto weapons fire. A-1 moved as directed to position to support A-3. A-3 continued withdrawl. Med-evac picked up remaining WIA's and KIA's. A-3 estimated enemy force to be an NVA Co(Rein).
