From 1 June until 30 June the Battalion was responsible for the assigned sector of the KHE SANH Operating Area. Additionally the Battalion was responsible for providing a rifle company (Rein) as a Regimental Reserve, a force for SPARROW HAWK, ROUGH RIDER Relief, perimeter security for the KHE SANH Airfield and facilities and a relief force for the LANG VEI Special Forces Camp.

The Battalion's mission was to occupy key terrain features to prevent enemy movement into vital areas and conduct extensive and intensive patrolling in order to detect and destroy enemy forces and interdict enemy routes of approach into the KHE SANH area. Operation CROCKETT continued throughout the month. Search and destroy and reconnaissance in force missions were assigned to the Battalion.

During the reporting period there was an increase in enemy activity as both friendly patrols and defensive positions came under attack.

Friendly activity during this period consisted mainly of company daylight combat and reconnaissance patrols and platoon night ambushes. Additionally a Company Patrol Base was established to protect the bridge at coordinates XD 913403. Company Patrol Bases on Hills 861 and 881S continued to be improved during this reporting period.

On 5 June Representatives INCHORD (D) Mo., and LONG (D) La. accompanied by BGen METZGER visited the KHE SANH combat base and spoke to members of the Battalion.

On 7 June Company "B" on Hill 881S was visited by BGen METZGER.

On 10 June BGen METZGER visited Company "D" on Hill 950, Company "C" on Hill 861 and Company "B" on Hill 881S.

On 25 June BGen METZGER visited Company "B" on Hill 881S.

On 26 June LtGen KRULAK & MajGen HOCHMUTH visited Company "B" on Hill 881S and Company "D" on Hill 861.

On 28 June BGen METZGER visited Company "B" on Hill 881S.

PART III: SEQUENTIAL LISTING
OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. Personnel

a. Losses are as follows:

- (1) 3 Marine Officers transferred for duty.
- (2) 29 Marine Enlisted transferred for duty and 13 by service records by reason of Medevac.
- (3) 8 USN Enlisted transferred for duty and 1 transferred by service records by reason of Medevac.

b. Joining are as follows:

- (1) 2 Marine Officers joined for duty.
- (2) 77 Marine and 9 Navy Enlisted joined for duty.

c. Casualties for the period are as follows:

- (1) 24 Marine Enlisted KIA, 1 USN Enlisted KIA.
- (2) 1 Marine Officer and 3 Marine Enlisted DOW.
- (3) 4 Marine Officers, 86 Marine Enlisted and 7 USN Enlisted WIA.

2. Administrative. On 16 June 1967, The Battalion S-1 Rear was moved from PHU BAI forward to KHE SANH. A small rear detachment is maintained at PHU BAI consisting of two supply security personnel and one S-1 Liaison NCO to handle casualties and assist R&R personnel passing through the Division CP area.

3. Intelligence

a. Enemy Activity. Enemy activity for the month of June was moderate. The following significant contacts occurred during the month:

- (1) On the 6th, KHE SANH Airfield received 20-25 rounds of mortar and rocket fire. The rounds appeared to come from the following coordinates XD 803464. Counter mortar plan was fired.
- (2) At 0200 on the morning of the 6th, elements of this command on Hill 950, at XD 844456, reported they were being attacked. Approximately 40-50 NVA from the 6th Battalion, 95th Regiment of the 325C Division participated in the attack. The enemy force approached Hill 950 from Hill 1015 to the east, surrounding the outpost and assaulting. NVA remained within the outpost's perimeter until daylight when they withdrew. The enemy utilized grenades, rockets and small arms during the attack; the majority of the enemy carried AK47's. The enemy suffered 10 KIA(C).

(3) On the 7th, Co B(-) while on patrol at XD 760445, vicinity of Hill 821, came under a heavy small arms and mortar attack from XD 756439. Approximately 20-30 rounds of 82mm mortar fire were received. Co B(-) was then assaulted from the west by approximately 30-40 NVA. The attack was repulsed and the enemy withdrew to the west. When the Medevac Helicopter landed, small arms fire was received from the north. Two platoons and the CP group from Co A were helilifted to Hill 881S to support Co B(-). The 3rd platoon from Co B and the Co A Command Group moved from Hill 881S to Hill 821 to provide security for the movement of Co B(-). Under cover of Air, the Co A Command Group returned with Co B to Hill 881S. It is estimated that the enemy unit at XD 756439 was 1 NVA Co and that another Co was located to the north of 821. Enemy casualties were 23 KIA(C) and 17 KIA(P).

(4) On the night of 26-27 June, KHE SANH Airfield received mortar and rocket fire. At 0040, approximately 40 rounds 82mm mortar fire was received from XD 820395. The counter mortar plan was fired. At 0531 approximately 50 rocket rounds were received from XD 778398 and XD 790410. When counter mortar plan was fired one secondary explosion occurred at XD 852447. The action resulted in 7 KIA USMC and 48 WIA USMC. Co B on Hill 881S observed enemy rockets at 0531 coming from the southern slope of Hill 758 (XD 784422). At daylight USAF AD spotted mortar positions near Hill 659, (XD 802409) that were occupied by approximately 10 NVA and bunker positions in vicinity of Hill 758 on the southern slope. Air strikes were run on both positions.

b. Weather*. Rainfall for the month was moderate. All lines of communications were open to wheeled vehicles and movement of infantry was unimpaired.

4. Training. On the job training was conducted for all MOS's. The seven day indoctrination period for newly arrived personnel was carried out and proved to be highly effective. All newly joined personnel completed familiarization firing of the M-16, and a refresher course was held for infantry personnel in the Battalion.

5. Special Operations

Co "D" arrived in LANG VEI in conjunction with Operation ROUND UP at 031020H.

Co "D" returned from Operation ROUND UP at 031900H.

Co "A" reaction force at 050730H was deployed to search for one USMC MIA at XD 904399.

Co "A" returns from search for one USMC MIA at 061600H.

6. NBC Defense. Nothing significant.

7. Command and Control. The Battalion was commanded by LtCol D.E. NEWTON throughout the reporting period. 1st Battalion, 26th Marines remained AdCon 3rd Marine Division and OpCon to the 26th Marine Regiment during the entire month of June.

8. Communication and Electronics. nothing significant.

9. Close Combat. During the month of June close combat with the enemy occurred on two occasions.

On the morning of 6 June, the Battalion radio relay station on Hill 950, at XD 844456, was attacked by approximately 40-50 NVA. The enemy broke into the perimeter and attacked with grenades and small arms. The attack was broken when artillery was called in on the position; the enemy fled at daybreak. The action resulted in 10 NVA KIA(C).

On the afternoon of 7 June Co B(-) was attacked while on patrol at XD 760445. Co B(-) received approximately 20-30 82mm mortar rounds and then was immediately assaulted by 30-40 NVA. The enemy troops attacked under cover of their mortar fire, which enabled them to get within grenade range of Co B(-). The attack was repulsed at close range by small arms fire and hand grenades. The enemy's mortar positions were destroyed by artillery and air strikes. Two platoons from Co A were helilifted to support Co B(-) in their movement to Hill 881S. The enemy suffered 23 KIA(C) and 17 KIA(F) as a result of the action.

10. Fire Support and Fire Support Coordination. During June artillery fired on targets of opportunity, fired zone fires on suspected enemy positions, harassment and interdiction fires and registration missions. Both offensive and defensive on call fires were utilized during the reporting period.

Artillery fired 40 missions against known enemy during June. Casualties resulting from artillery were 3 KIA(C) and 10 KIA(F). Confirmed figures might have been higher but conditions in many cases precluded an immediate search of the target area. Surveillance by FO's indicated that artillery fires were both effective and accurate.

Two 81mm Mortar sections were attached to outlying rifle companies. The remaining two sections were kept in the KHE SANH Airfield perimeter in a general support role. 263 observed and unobserved fire missions were fired during June.

11. Logistics. During this reporting period the companies were supplied 482,000 lbs. of supplies by H-34 and H-46. M-35 trucks carried 24,500 lbs. of cargo in support of resupply efforts. Battalion and house keeping vehicles traveled 6,610 miles in support of the Battalion.

New developments for the reporting period include one 20 x 60 BAS bunker, one 12 x 20 FDC bunker and 4 living bunkers built with locally available material. The most significant problem area is the lack of tropical light-weight utilities and repair parts for M274A1 mules.

12. Air Defense. Nothing significant.

13. Combat Air Support. During this reporting period the Battalion air section has continued to maintain two forward air control teams with forward companies on Hills 861 and 881S. Excellent observation from these positions has enabled the forward air control teams to control numerous fixed wing airstrikes. In addition to 165 TAC(A) controlled airstrikes in support of 1/26 the FAC Teams have controlled 82 fixed wing support missions. The quick response time, armed reconnaissance, and direct air support capability of the UH-1E helicopters continued to be invaluable. During this reporting period the following battle damage assessment was attributed to air strikes: 49 bunkers destroyed, 12 secondary explosions, 17 KBA(C) and 62 KBA(P). Helicopters resupply of all forward units has continued. 241 tons of supplies were airlifted during this period. The air section (Rear) and Forward air control parties have controlled 27 Medevac missions during this month.

14. Medical. During the month of June, 8 corpsmen were transferred to other commands for duty, 1 corpsman was evacuated out of country with Malaria, and 1 corpsman was KIA, for a total of 10 transfers. Five (5) new corpsmen were received for duty during this period. During the month 8 corpsmen were WIA; 6 were treated and returned to full duty, 2 were evacuated for further treatment and are still in country. At the present time there are 7 corpsmen hospitalized at NSA for medical treatment of non-hostile diseases. The overall personnel status at the present time is 53 enlisted and 1 officer with 9 being non-effective, and 46 being effective. Combat casualties handled by BAS personnel during June were 22 KIA's, and 121 WIA's; with 41 WIA's treated and returned to full duty, and 80 WIA's treated and held, or evacuated for further treatment. Average daily patient census at the BAS for the month was 18. During June, 594 Marines were treated and seen at routine sick call. Immunizations for June were provided by the Sub-

Unit 5 dispensary pending the arrival of BAS's supply of Biologicals. Ground improvements for the month consisted of 90% completion of Phase I of the BAS bunker complex. This bunker, planned for in-patient holding, is also being used as a casualty triage and treatment center until such time as additional bunker space is constructed.

15. Chaplain and Moral Welfare. Battalion Chaplain (Protestant) was located at KHE SANH for the entire month. Protestant services were held for the CP group Sunday morning and afternoons, and for all rifle companies during the week. Battalion Chaplain normally spent one or two nights weekly with rifle companies on Hill 864 and 881S. A total of 22 Protestant services were held in Battalion, attended by 777 men. Battalion Chaplain gave orientation lectures to 22 replacement troops, counseled with 48 Marines, visited patients in the BAS daily when possible, made visits to 163 casualties in hospitals and C&C areas, wrote 26 pastoral letters to NOK of KIA's, handled 5 cases with AmCross, and distributed over 2100 New Testaments and religious booklets.

During the month, Battalion Chaplain provided Protestant services for the following units: CAP O-1, CAP O-2, CAP O-3, and Special Forces at BINH VEI. From 19-30 June he also provided Protestant services for 3/26 units. A total of 15 services were thus conducted for other units attended by 325 men.

During the period of 10-30 June, Roman Catholic masses were provided for 1/26 units by the Battalion Chaplain of 3/26.

Battalion Chaplain was absent from command area 12-17 June to attend a portion of the Annual Conference of the Christian and Missionary Alliance at DALAT.

16. Civic Action. Nothing significant.


