NARRATIVE SUMMARY

From 1 July to 31 July the Battalion's mission was to occupy key terrain features to prevent enemy movement into vital areas; to conduct extensive patrolling to detect and destroy enemy forces and to interdict enemy routes of approach to the KHE SANH area; to maintain one company as regimental reserve; to be prepared to effect ROUGH RIDER relief; to be prepared to relieve/reinforce the Special Forces Camp at LANG VEI; and to provide perimeter security for the assigned sector of the KHE SANH Combat Base.

OPERATION CROCKETT terminated on 16 July and OPERATION APDMORE commenced on 17 July and continued throughout the remainder of the month. Search and destroy and reconnaissance in force operations were conducted by the Battalion in conjunction with these operations.

During the reporting period there was a noted decrease of enemy activity in the KHE SANH Operating Area.

Friendly activity during this period consisted primarily of company daylight combat and reconnaissance patrols and platoon night ambushes. Company positions on Hills 861 and 881S and at the bridge site at coordinates XD 913403 continued to be improved during this reporting period.

Company "A" relieved Company "B" on Hill 881S on 10 July.

Company "C" continued to maintain a defensive position and combat patrol base at coordinates XD 913403.

Company "D" continued to occupy Hill 861.

Company "B" reverted to Battalion Reserve on 10 July and operated from the KHE SANH Combat Base.

On 31 July 1967 Company "M", 3rd Battalion, 26th Marines was attached for the conduct of a Battalion (-) clearing operation.

HIGHLIGHTS

On 4 July LtCol J.B. WILKINSON relieved LtCol D.E. NEWTON as Battalion Commander.

On 6 July BGen METZGER visited H&S Company during the conduct of small arms training and firing.

On 16 July BGen METZGER visited Company "A" on Hill 881S.

On 20 July MajGen ROCHMITH and MajGen PRAPSON visited Company "A" on Hill 881S.

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. Combat missions assigned. During the period 1 July to 31 July the Battalion's mission was to occupy key terrain features to prevent enemy movement into vital areas; to conduct extensive patrolling to detect and destroy enemy forces and interdict enemy routes of approach to the KHE SANH area; to maintain one company as regimental reserve; to be prepared to effect ROUGH RIDER relief; to be prepared to relieve/reinforce the Special Forces Camp at LANG VEI; and to provide perimeter security for the assigned sector of the KHE SANH Combat Base.

2. Significant operations conducted.

a. Participated in OPERATION CROCKETT from 1 July to 162400H July.

b. Participated in OPERATION APDMOPE from 170001H July to 31 July. OPERATION APDMOPE continues.

c. Conducted Battalion (-) (Command Group, Companies "B" and "C" (-)) clearing operation in the vicinity of Route 9 from XD 9140 to XD 9143 to XD 9440 to XD 9443 during the period 21-29 July. Operation commenced as a result of a Company B patrol contact at 211030H. 1st Platoon, Company B while conducting a clearing patrol and moving east along the northern edge of Route 9 made contact with an NVA platoon located at XD 951432 supported by a heavy weapons platoon. The enemy appeared to have been surprised when B-1 approached the flank of the enemy position oriented along Route 9. The enemy opened fire when the B-1 lead elements were within 20 meters of their position. B-1 received 82mm mortar fire from Hill 214 (XD 945435), recoilless rifle, automatic and semi-automatic weapons fire from the enemy positions vicinity XD 915432. B-1 was supported by artillery and air (HULE gunships). During the artillery and air preparation B-1 reorganized and prepared an attack on the enemy position. As B-1 advanced toward the enemy position the NVA broke contact and moved north along a trail located at XD 945424. As a result of the B-1 contact the Battalion Command Group and the Battalion Reserve, Company B (-), moved to B-1's position. A Battalion (-) clearing operation was conducted along Route 9 until 29 July employing Company B and Company C (-) to ensure the safe passage of a series of POUCH PIDEFS through the 26th Marines' TAOP. The B-1 contact resulted in 3 friendly KIA, 6 friendly WIA's, and 7 NVA KIA (C). During the subsequent Battalion (-) operation the following enemy equipment was captured: three AK-47's, one RPG-2, three claymore mines, five NVA packs each containing a new hammock, several sheets of plastic water proofing material, a mosquito net, blasting caps, fuze lighters, and TNT.

d. At 311300H July the Battalion commenced a Battalion (-) clearing operation employing Company G (-) and Company M, 3rd Battalion, 26th Marines to provide for the security of a series of POUCH RIDERS along Route 9 during the period 1-3 August. The operational area for this

5. New techniques employed. Nothing significant.

6. Command relations

a. The Battalion operated under the operational command of 26th Marines and the administrative control of 3rd Marine Division (Rein).

b. The Battalion assumed operational control of Company "M", 3rd Battalion, 26th Marines effective 311300H July.

7. Equipment. Nothing significant.

8. Logistics

a. During this reporting period the deployed companies were supplied with 660,000 pounds of supplies by CH-34 and CH-46 aircraft.

b. M-35's carried 35,000 pounds of cargo in support of resupply efforts.

c. Battalion vehicles traveled 3,613 miles in support of Battalion.

d. The special allowance of M-37 trucks was received but were administratively deadlined awaiting initial provisioning of spare parts.

e. Cantonment improvements included the construction of additional bunkers on the KHE SANH perimeter. The construction of a new COC bunker was also begun in July.

9. Civic action. Nothing significant.

10. Administration. Company Pears maintained at the Battalion CP to provide administrative support of the deployed companies.

11. Personnel

a. Losses:

- (1) 4 Marine Officers transferred for duty.
- (2) 24 Marine Enlisted transferred for duty and 35 by service records as a result of Medevac.
- (3) 1 USN Officer transferred for duty.
- (4) 13 USN Enlisted transferred for duty and 3 transferred by service records as a result of Medevac.

b. Joinings:

- (1) 5 Marine Officers joined for duty.
- (2) 91 Marine and 21 Navy Enlisted joined for duty.

c. Casualties:

- (1) 3 Marine Enlisted KIA, 0 USN Enlisted KIA.
- (2) 0 Marine Officer and 0 Marine Enlisted DOW.
- (3) 0 Marine Officers, 5 Marine Enlisted and 2 USN Enlisted WIA.

d. During the month of July 113 men from the Battalion went on P&R and six men were granted emergency leave.

12. Intelligence

a. During the Battalion (-) operation conducted during 21-29 July, evidence of an enemy ambush site along the north side of Route 9 was discovered. The ambush position covered the road east and west of a bypass at XD 944423. Fighting holes were within 10 meters of the road. On 21 July, the day of the B-1 contact described above, Company "L", 3rd Marines operating to the east of the Regimental TAOP, in the vicinity of XD 956428 found claymore mines and fighting holes along Route 9. At XD 956435 Company "L" found a battalion size harbor site including 25 reinforced bunkers, 60 holes that appeared to be bunkers under construction, and 8 cooking houses with underground smoke tunnels. There were OP's on the high ground surrounding the harbor site, each with bunkers, comm wire to the harbor site and well used trails. The position-

ing of the claymore mines found by both units indicated that the ambush site was in excess of 2000 meters along Route 9. Route 9 is relatively straight at this point and provided the enemy a long beaten zone for a convoy ambush. The road is narrow with a steep gorge and river on the south side and high ground to the north.

b. Numerous lights were spotted during the month south of Hill 881S (XD 778438). In particular, Company A reported stationary blinking lights at XD 785413 on 29 July at 2140H. Artillery zone fire missions into the area resulted in ten secondary explosions.

13. Communications. Nothing significant.

14. Weather. Rainfall for the month was moderate. All lines of communications were open to wheeled vehicles and the movement of infantry was unimpaired, except for the period 25-27 July during which Route 9 was impassible to vehicles in the vicinity of XD 913403 due to erosion of the road bed from sustained traffic over a wet surface.

No other statistics on weather conditions were available due to the lack of recording facilities at KHE SANH.

15. Fire support and Fire Support coordination. During the month of July artillery units in direct/general support of the Battalion provided the normal types of fire support missions. 193 observed fire missions were conducted during the reporting period. Three 81mm Mortar sections were attached to the deployed rifle companies; one section remained at KHE SANH in general support. The platoon fired 148 observed fire missions and fired upon 2078 H&I targets.

16. Air support

a. During this period the Battalion has continued to maintain two forward air control teams with the companies on Hill 861 and 881S. Excellent observation from these positions has enabled the forward air control teams to control fixed wing airstrikes. The FAC teams controlled 36 fixed wing support missions during July.

b. 330 tons of supplies were lifted by helicopter to the units on Hills 861 and 881S during this reporting period. 21 MEDEVAC missions were coordinated and controlled by the Battalion Air Liason Section and Forward Air Control teams.

c. The Battalion FAC has begun flying as AO in U.S. Air Force OIC "BIPDDOGS" stationed at KHE SANH. This added reconnaissance and

observation capability and improved means of controlling fixed wing strikes should prove to be an asset to the Battalion.

17. Medical. Average daily patient census at the BAS for the month was 9. During July 694 Marines were treated at routine sick call and 485 immunizations were administered.

18. Chaplain and Moral Welfare. A Protestant Chaplain was not available to the Command during the period 9-20 July due to the transfer of the Battalion Chaplain without a contact relief. During the period 20-31 July a total of 15 Protestant services were conducted with a total attendance of 436 personnel. Roman Catholic Masses were celebrated for the Battalion by the 3rd Battalion, 26th Marines Chaplain. The Battalion Chaplain also conducted services at the Regimental Radio Relay Station (Hill 950), and the CAC "O" HQ in KHE SANH Village for personnel attached to the three CAP units. Three orientation lectures were presented to approximately 70 men. Approximately 80 Bibles were distributed, in addition to tracts and other literature. Counseling cases numbered 12.

19. Personnel and morale services.

a. Postal. Approximately twelve (12) bags of mail are received every other day. Although some delays in delivery have been noted, service is normally timely.

b. Special services. Two hundred (200) cases of soft drinks furnished by Division Special Services were delivered to the companies during the month.

c. Decorations and awards. Three (3) personnel were recommended for award of the Silver Star Medal and nine (9) were recommended for award of the Bronze Star Medal for combat actions during July. Twenty-eight (28) personnel were awarded the Purple Heart Medal and three (3) personnel were awarded Gold Stars in lieu of the award of a second Purple Heart.
