## PART II

OPERATIONAL SUMMARY

During August the Battalion's mission remained unchanged. The Battalion continued to defend key terrain, conduct extensive patrolling and night ambushes, and defend assigned sectors of the KHE SANH Combat Base.

Operation ARDMORE continued throughout the month of August. Search and clear, search and destroy, reconnaissance in force operations, and road security operations were conducted in conjunction with Operation ARDMORE.

During the reporting period enemy activity in the KHE SANH operating area continued to be light.

During August the Battalion completed the Battalion (-) road clearing and security operation along Route 9 which commenced on 31 July 1967. The Battalion also conducted three company size search and destroy operations. The company defensive positions and Combat Patrol Bases on Hills 881S and 861 continued to be improved. The defensive positions and Combat Base located at XD 912400 were disestablished as a result of the removal of the 11th Engineer Battalion bridge at XD 912403.

Company A continued to occupy a defensive position and Combat Patrol Base on Hill 881S.

Company B relieved Company D on Hill 861 on 4 August.

Company D returned to KHE SANH Combat Base on 4 August and conducted Battalion Reserve missions.

Company B occupied the Battalion's assigned defensive sectors of KHE SANH Combat Base on 14 August relieving B&S Company.

Company C disestablished the defensive position and patrol base at XD 912400, returned to KHE SANH Combat Base on 15 August, and was assigned the Battalion Reserve missions.

Company C relieved Company D and occupied the Battalion's assigned defensive sectors of KHE SANH Combat Base on 31 August.

On 7 August the Commandant of the Marine Corps visited Company A on Hill 881S.

## PART III

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. Combat missions assigned. During the period 1 August to 31 August the Battalion's mission was to occupy key terrain features to prevent enemy movement into vital areas; to conduct extensive patrolling to detect and destroy enemy forces and interdict enemy routes of approach to the KHE SANH area; to maintain one Company as Regimental Reserve; to provide forces for local security operations in support of KHE SANH Combat Base; and to provide screening/concealment operations in support of reconnaissance insertions.

2. Significant operations conducted.

a. Participated in Operation ARDMORE during the entire month. Operation ARDMORE continues.

b. Battalion (-) road clearing operation employing Company C (-) and Company M, 3d Battalion, 26th Marines along Route 9 from XD 919403 to XD 950427 which commenced on 31 July was terminated on 4 August.

c. Company D (Rein) conducted a 5 day search and destroy operation commencing 8 August 1967 in an area bounded by XD 790460, XD 790480, XD 820460, XD 820480, XD 830420 and XD 840420.

d. Company C (Rein) conducted a 6 day search and destroy operation commencing 25 August 1967 in an area bounded by XD 770390, XD 770430, XD 820400, XD 820380, XD 800380, and XD 800390.

e. Company D (Rein) commenced a search and destroy operation on 31 August 1967 from XD 770400, XD 770430, XD 800390, XD 800400, XD 820390, and XD 820405. Operation continues.

3. Casualties inflicted on the enemy.

a. Personnel: None.

b. Weapons captured: Two (2) individual weapons.

4. Casualties sustained. None.

5. New techniques employed. Long Range Patrol Rations were used on the three company sized operations during the month. The use of these rations enabled company sized units to carry five (5) days of Class I supplies and yet carry a relatively light individual load. A result of the utilization of Long Range Patrol Rations is that helicopter resupply was not required and units were, therefore, not restricted to operations in areas where LZ's were available and the unit's locations were not compromised by the conduct of resupply operations. The only disadvantage of the utilization of Long Range Patrol Rations is the requirement for an abundant natural water source in the operating area in order to prepare the meals and to combat the lingering after thirst.

6. Command relations. The Battalion operated under the operational control of the 26th Marines and the administrative control of the 3d Marine Division (Rein).

7. Equipment. The Battalion received three Starlight Scopes during August. Division contact teams trained each company in the techniques of employment and maintenance of the Starlight Scopes.

8. Logistics.

a. During this reporting period the deployed Companies were supplied with 1,236,000 pounds of supplies by CH-34 and CH-46 aircraft.

b. Organic vehicles traveled 3,641 miles in support of the Battalion.

c. The Battalion supply and motor transport sections were inspected by Division contact teams on procedures and management.

d. Contonment improvements included completion of new COC bunker, living bunkers in the KHE-SANH perimeter and living and fighting positions on Hills 881S and 861.

9. Civic action.

a. During the month visits were made to the day school at KHE-SANH. Foods and games were distributed to the children.

b. Personnel joining the Command from CONUS were given civic action lectures as part of the Battalion Replacement Training Program. Classes included, "Why We Are Here", "Learning about VIETNAM" and the "VIETNAMESE and the Revolutionary Development Program".

10. Administration. Company Rears were maintained at the Battalion CP to provide administrative support for the deployed Companies.

11. Personnel.

a. Losses:

(1) Nine (9) Marine Officers transferred for duty.

(2) Two hundred and twenty-five (225) Marine Enlisted transferred for duty. Fifteen (15) transferred by Service Records as a result of MedEvac.

(3) There were no USN Officers transferred for duty.

(4) Six (6) USN Enlisted transferred for duty. Two (2) transferred by Service Records as a result of MedEvac.

b. Joinings:

- (1) Three (3) Marine Officers joined for duty.
- (2) One hundred forty-eight (148) Marines and one (1) Navy Enlisted joined for duty.

c. Casualties:

- (1) There were no KIA's during the month.
- (2) One (1) Enlisted Marine died from drowning while attempting to aid VIETNAMESE civilians in crossing a rain swollen stream and one (1) enlisted Marine died from disease.
- (3) There were no DOW's during the month.
- (4) There were no WIA's during the month.
- (5) A total of twenty-seven (27) non-hostile casualties were evacuated to C Med during the month.

d. During the month of August ninety-two (92) men from the Battalion went on R&R and five (5) men were granted emergency leave.

e. During the month of August one (1) WELREP was obtained from the Red Cross on an individual's wife; one (1) WELREP on the health of a Marine Officer's mother resulted in emergency leave.

12. Informational Services.

a. During the month of August there were 1065 individual news releases distributed to the Fleet Home Town News Service by the local representative of Division Informational News Service Office.

b. There were seven (7) full-length stories written about members of this Battalion.

c. Four (4) civilian correspondents visited the Battalion area during the month.

13. Intelligence.

a. Enemy activity. Enemy activity for the month of August was light. The following significant contacts occurred:

- (1) At 102205H August Company A on Hill 881S reported that a listening post heard movement of an unknown number of personnel. During an illumination mission 4-5 personnel were sighted at XD 775442. Artillery and mortar missions were fired with unknown results.



(2) At 191815H August Scout/Snipers attached to Company A on Hill 881S observed two (2) NVA wearing pith helmets, light green utilities and carrying weapons at XD 778435. Soon afterwards two (2) more NVA were sighted at the same location. Artillery and mortar missions were fired with unknown results.

(3) Numerous lights were spotted during this month. In particular at 022045H Company A spotted six (6) lights at XD 768321. An artillery mission was fired and the lights went out. At 272045H, Company C spotted three (3) lights moving east at XD 802387. An artillery mission was fired and the lights went out.

b. Surveillance.

(1) Amplifier problems reduced the availability of the AN/TPS-21 during the month. Two (2) contacts were made on the 2nd, however, when the AN/TPS-21 was employed at the Company D position on Hill 861. At 021315H contact was made with approximately 10-15 personnel. At 022235H, contact was made with an unknown number of personnel at XD 770446. Artillery missions were brought on both targets with unknown results.

(2) Three (3) Starlight Scopes were received and issued to Companies A, B, and C.

(3) The Seismic Intrusion Devices were employed at all fixed positions. No contacts were made.

14. Communications. Nothing significant.

15. Weather.

- a. Maximum Temperature - 93.
- b. Minimum Temperature - 69.
- c. Average Humidity - 85%.
- d. Total Precipitation - 9.03 inches.
- e. Average Wind Speed - 7.3 miles per hour.
- f. Average Visibility - 11 miles.

16. Fire support and fire support coordination. During the month of August artillery units in direct/general support of the Battalion provided the normal types of fire support missions. One hundred twenty-five (125) observed fire missions were conducted during the reporting period. Three (3) 81mm Mortar Sections were attached to the deployed rifle companies; one section remained in KHE SANE in general support. The platoon fired one hundred ninety-two (192) observed fire missions

and fired 2,108 H&I targets. The 81mm Mortar Platoon with three (3) sections attached to deployed companies could support the Battalion elements along a 22,000 meter line from 1 August to 15 August.

17. Air support.

a. During this period the Battalion has continued to maintain two (2) Forward Air Control teams with the companies on Hills 861 and 881S. Excellent observation from these positions enabled the FAC Teams to control airstrikes but several periods of poor weather have decreased the number of airstrikes controlled. Twenty-six (26) were controlled during the month of August.

b. 1,236,000 pounds of supplies were lifted by helicopter to the units on Hill 861 and 881S and to other deployed units during the reporting period.

c. Twenty-three (23) MedEvac missions were coordinated and controlled by the Battalion Air Liaison Section and Forward Air Control teams.

d. The Battalion FAC was limited by weather but did fly several AO missions within the TAOR and controlled several airstrikes. This airstrike capability continues to be an asset to the Battalion.

18. Psychological operations.

a. On 5 August a broadcast team from the 244th PsyOps Company, USA was lifted by helicopter to join Co C (-) (Rein) combat patrol at XD 912433. The team conducted a sixty (60) minute broadcast directed to suspected enemy units located in the north and northeast.

b. On 20 August a broadcast team from the 244th PsyOps Company, USA conducted a sixty (60) minute broadcast from Co A positions on Hill 881S. Broadcast directed to the north and northeast.

c. On 21 August a broadcast team from the 244th PsyOps Company, USA accompanied Co A (-) (Rein) combat patrol to Hill 778 (XD 743433). Sixty (60) minute Chieu Hoi broadcast directed toward suspected enemy units located on and to the west of Hill 918 (XD 725444).

19. Medical. During the month nine hundred sixty-seven (967) Marines were seen and treated at routine sick call. Significant illnesses include seven (7) cases of dysentery; twenty-six (26) cases of fever of unknown origin, six (6) of which required evacuation; and nine (9) personnel evacuated with the diagnosis of malaria. Three hundred seventy (370) immunizations were administered during the month.

20. Religion and moral welfare. During the period 1 August to 31 August thirty (30) Protestant services were conducted with a total attendance of eight hundred sixty-five (865) personnel. Roman Catholic Masses were celebrated for the Battalion by the 3rd Battalion's

Chaplain. The Battalion Chaplain also conducted services at the Regimental Relay Station (Hill 950); Detachment A-101, U. S. Special Forces at LANG VEI; the CAC "O" Headquarters and platoon units in the KHE SANH area. A total of five (5) troop indoctrination lectures were given to a total of one hundred thirty-one (131) men. Two (2) memorial services were held jointly with the 3rd Battalion Chaplain for two (2) deceased personnel (non-battle casualties). BAS was visited weekly and Confirmation classes were begun for one Marine.

21. Personnel and morale services.

a. Postal. Battalion mail personnel handled approximately eight (8) bags of mail per day. This includes packages, letters, newspapers and magazines for members of this Command.

b. Special services. Distributed 1100 stationary kits, ten (10) game kits, and eight hundred (800) paper back books. Also placed an order for 1200 lighters with crest to be distributed to members of the Battalion on the Marine Corps Birthday.

c. Decorations and awards. The following decorations were awarded during the month of August.

(1) One (1) Officer and seventeen (17) Enlisted were awarded the Purple Heart Medal.

(2) Three (3) Enlisted were awarded the CG, 3rd Marine Division Certification of Commendation.

(3) One (1) Officer was awarded the VIETNAMESE Medal of Honor.



**1. SUMMARY OF ENEMY SITUATION.**

a. There is no indication that the enemy is now operating in this specific AO. However, the enemy has in the past used the valley area for infiltration and built positions from which to mortar and rocket the airfield. Recently signs of heavy enemy activity have been observed to the northwest vicinity (XD 8649). Company M, 3rd Battalion, 26th Marines made contact with a platoon size force on the 18th of July 1967. Reconnaissance team insertion on Hill 1371 within the last week found signs of heavy enemy activity on the forward slope of the hill. A trail runs up to a possible observation post and a 50-60 man harbor site was found.

b. The enemy has the capability of taking the offensive with up to a battalion in the AO, however, the probability that he will do so is small, as he would expose himself to Hill's 861 and 950. Further, the enemy has the capability of defending several small hill masses in the AO, Hill's 632, 635, and 527 with up to a battalion. Probability again is small as no new bunkers or other emplacements have been observed. The enemy lines of communication to the AO runs generally from East to West along trails located at (XD 849490) to (XD 819485) and Northwest to Southwest from (XD 798506) to (XD 805476).

**2. ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF INFORMATION.****a. GENERAL.**

- (1) Determine the most likely routes of approach and withdrawal into the AO.
- (2) Determine if the enemy has built any new emplacements in the AO, if so, where, what type?
- (3) Determine suitable helicopter landing zones in the AO.
- (4) Determine if natural water sources are being used for resupply for enemy units operating in the AO.







1. SUMMARY OF ENEMY SITUATION.

a. Enemy activity within the AO has been limited to 2-3 man reconnaissance teams. However, the enemy has used HILL 689 in the past as an observation post from which to mortar and rocket the KHE SANH AIRFIELD. Companies I and L, 3rd Battalion, 26th Marines made contact with a estimated NVA company occupying HILL 689 and the area to the west on the 27th of June 1967. Company I operating in the vicinity of HILL 689 from 6-10 August 1967 found a harbor site at XD 802408.

b. The enemy has the capability of taking the offensive with up to a battalion in the AO. The possibility that he will do this is small. Further, the enemy could defend HILL 689, as he did in the past and also HILL 557 to the west of the AO. The probability that the enemy would take this course of action is small as he would expose himself to HILL 881 SOUTH. The enemy lines of communications in the AO run generally East to West along trails located at XD 801408 to XD 784398 and a two foot wide trail at XD 776425.

2. ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF INFORMATION.

a. GENERAL.

- (1) Determine the capability of the enemy defending HILL 689. If so, with what forces?
- (2) Determine if the enemy has build any new emplacements in the AO. If so, where, how where they constructed?
- (3) Determine suitable helicopter landing zones in the AO. What size, any obstacles in zone, how many CH-46's can land?
