Dennis arrived in Vietnam and was assigned to H & S Company, 1st Battalion, 26th Marine Regiment, 3rd Marine Division.

The battalion was participating in Operation Prairie when the Marines encountered hostile forces 2 kilometers north northeast of Con Thien. Lt Bradley died from an enemy mortar round resulting in multiple fragmentation wounds to the head and right shoulder.

1st Lt Bradley served his country for 3 years.
